Requirements:

All paddlers must wear a helmet and a PFD.
Boats are expected to have legal, blunt ends.
This is an ACA-sanctioned race; membership or
\$5 event fee is required with signed ACA waiver.

Course:

This course is appropriate for beginning and
intermediate boaters.

2. Acknowledges and fully understands that each participant will be engaging in activities that involve risk of serious injury, including permanent disability and death, and severe social and economic losses to person or property which might result not only from his/her own actions, inactions, or negligence, but also the actions, inactions, or negligence of others, the rules of play, or the condition of the premises or of any equipment used.
