**Registration:**

Pre-registration deadline: postmarked on or before August 4, 2010  
Late registration (by email or post) will be accepted until Saturday, August 7

**Entry Fees:**

\$15.00 for 1st class, 2nd class fee \$5.00. There is a two-class limit for all groups.

**Classes:**

K1, K1W, C1, C1W, C2, C2 Mixed, C-2W; race boats, recreational boats (plastic), and open boats.  
Classes will be grouped as necessary with three boats needed for awards.  
Cadet and Junior age group classes will not be grouped.

**Water Schedule:**

**Saturday:** Free training on the course once it's set-up. Late registration table available.

**Sunday:** 9:30 –10:00 a.m. Pick up bibs  
9:45 a.m. Course closes  
10:00 a.m. Team leaders and paddlers race meeting  
11:00 a.m. First boat off!  
Lunch Tentatively planned between runs.

**Requirements:**

All paddlers must wear a helmet and a PFD. Boats are expected to have legal, blunt ends. This is a USACK sanctioned race; membership or \$10 event fee is required with signed USACK waiver.

**Course:**

This 12–15 gate course is appropriate for beginning and intermediate boaters. Please note: The stream bank has a lot of sharp rocks and debris *so footwear is absolutely necessary.*

**Directions to the Site:**

*From north on US 322:* Take E. Charles Street, (US 522 West) exit. Headquarters will be at the west end of the park along which you are traveling.

*From south and east,* take the Lewistown exit (US 22 west). In town along the Juniata River turn right on Charles Street, US 522 east and go 4 blocks, turn left on Dorcas Street, cross the bridge and find Rec Park.

*From the west coming in on US 22 and 522* take the Charles Street, US 522 exit to the left. Go 4 blocks, turn left on Dorcas Street, cross the bridge and find Rec Park. Parking on the north side of Dorcas Street Bridge. Rest rooms 200 yards east in Rec Park.

**Food:** A food booth *may* be onsite during the race on Sunday.
